I / we further acknowledge, and agree to accept, that risks, conditions, and dangers are inherent in (meaning an integral part of) TYR activities where horses and/or other equines, hereinafter referred to collectively as "equine," are present, regardless of all feasible safety measures which can be taken. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to: The tendency or inclination of equines to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, death, or loss to persons on or around the animals. Such behaviors include, but are not limited to: The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; hazards such as changes in surface or sub-surface conditions or materials; elements of nature such as thunder, lightning, rain, wind or insects; sights and/or a collision, encounter and/or confrontation with another equine, another animal, a person (familiar or unfamiliar), or an object. Reactions by an equine to these types of risks, conditions and dangers, or others, when frightened or provoked by them may divert the animal from its training and allow it to act according to its natural survival instincts which may include, but not be limited to: Kicking, biting, spinning, charging, bucking, rearing and/or running from danger. I / we also acknowledge that these are just some of the risks and I agree to assume others not mentioned above. I am not relying on TYR to list all possible risks for me.
